1. Chairman's Remarks and Apologies for Absence

2. Exclusion of Press and Public

4. Yorkshire Air Ambulance  
Members further considered a donation to the Yorkshire Air Ambulance following receipt of statistics showing attendance at incidents within the Town during the current calendar year. Proposed by Cllr. K Davis, seconded by Cllr. M Whittaker and  
RESOLVED:- That a donation of £1,000 be awarded to the Yorkshire Air Ambulance for attendance at incidents within the Town during the current calendar year.
